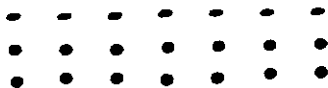

They appear on Law Co OH 1840 census in Mason twp. while there had children: Nancy, Sarah A., Caroline, William Thomas (My paternal Gr Grandfather), Elizabeth and Rebecca. When they left Law Co Oh in March 1850 for Gentry Co MO (now Worth Co MO) they had land in Section 25 Mason Twp.

Susan & Valentin HILGER b ca 1800 in Germany came to Law Co OH before the 1805 census and Valentin went to work in the Stone Quarries in Decatur Twp in or near Mt Vernon. In the family also b in Germany were 2 sons - Valentine b Aug 1829 & Peter and 2/3 dau all b after Valentin. Recently I found that gr gr grfater Valentin I, d in Decatur Twp Oct 1874. Where is he buried? Also found a Lana HILGER m Henry LAMPE in Ironton, OH Feb 1859 - what happened to the other children?? Valentin II m Elisebethe MARTIN b 1827 - Elisebeth had just arrived from Alsace-Lorraine Section of FR-GERMANY. Valentine II and Elisebeth were m in Evangelical United Church of Christ on Fifth St., Portsmouth, OH Dec 1853. Where did ELisebeth stay in Portsmouth before they were married? It seems that she came to NY ca 1845 and arrived in Portsmouth-Cincinnati area ca one yr later.
