## HOW TO WRITE YOUR QUERY

1. Your NAME, ADDRESS AND DATE SUBMITTED should be at the top of a 3 x 5 index card.
2. Please print or type your query.
3. Surnames should be in capital letters.
4. Keep your query as brief as possible. We would rather have several short queries than one very long one. Each member is entitled to at least one query.
5. Dates should be completely written such as 10 November 1878. This will assure mistakes in dates will not occur.
6. If your location is a city or town, include county name also. Do not abbreviate county names.

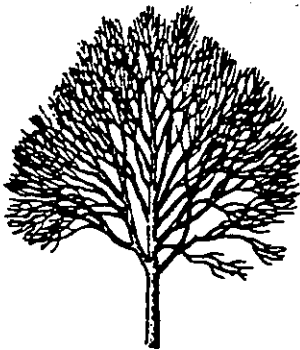

## INSTRUCTION FOR ANCESTOR CARD FILE

We would like a card for every ancestor about whom you have at least the name, one date and one place of residence that can identify him. The cards act as an index to your 5 generation chart.

These cards will be kept in the Ironton Library.

1. Use only 3 x 5 index cards.
2. Only one generation to a card, husband and wife should be on the same card if the information is known.
3. Type or block print in black ink the entire card, capitalizing the SURNAME, always using the surname first.
4. No card should be submitted unless it contains one name, one place and one date.
5. Make a cross index for wife, using maiden name.
6. No limit to number of cards which may be submitted. No restriction as to place of residence. It is not limited to Ohio. Any line you have may be submitted.
7. Name and address of person submitting card **MUST** be included in lower right hand corner of all cards, allowing for punched hole. No address labels please!
