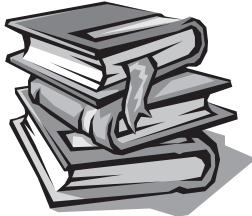

1895 ENUMERATION— UNION TOWNSHIP— PROCTORVILLE

I am searching for the Tabker family. On March 1, 1856 there was a deed recorded with John Tabker, grantee, and Henry Tabker, grantor, of Lawrence Co. On Aug. 15, 1851 Henry Tabker married Mary Lewisman in Scioto Co. The Mary Lewisman listed with her family on the 1850 census, died March 13, 1851, and is buried in St. Mary's cemetery. Henry Tabker went to Iowa and bought land in Delaware Co., adjacent to the Lewismans. A Lewisman niece, Anna Maria Bramme, emigrated from Germany in March 1849, at the same time as the Lewisman family. She was about 20. Could she be the "Maria" Lewisman who was my great grandmother.
