Dr. Dave Lucas was our guest speaker on Tuesday August 7, 2007. He is a popular instructor at Ohio University Southern, in Ironton. He spoke about the techniques used in researching the Porter Gap area, which is about a mile north of Ironton. This involved oral histories, records searches, and physical exploration of the area in question. He and his class used the clues discovered to relocate a black cemetery that had been overgrown and essentially forgotten many years ago. There are very few markers, for the many victims of a flu epidemic that are buried there. The cemetery has been restored and a new stone marking the site has been installed.

During the process of exploring the area, the class also located an abandoned D. T. & I. Railroad tunnel, that had been closed off many years ago, and remembers by only a few. Dr. Lucas showed a DVD of the day when his class and local media representatives used boats to explore the flooded tunnel. For the most part the tunnel is in surprisingly good condition, with crystal clear water allowing you to easily see the rails and timbering that were left in place when the tunnel was closed off. The society purchased a copy of the DVD and donated it to the Hamner Room. Anyone visiting the library may borrow and view this DVD using the computers in the Hamner Room.
