Lawrence County Genealogy Visits the County Recorders Office

At 6:30 PM on Tuesday April 6, the Lawrence County Recorder, Sharon Gossett Hager, welcomed members of the Lawrence County Genealogical Society to the Recorders Office in the county courthouse. Ms Gossett Hager was a very gracious host. She showed us through the office, telling us about the various records maintained there. The Recorders office holds all deeds, mortgages, liens, discharges and other legal papers that are not part of either criminal or civil court cases. She and clerk Kim Estep then were available to assist anyone who was trying to locate and obtain copies of specific documents.

Ms Gossett Hager also explained a major project that is nearing completion. The first 120 deed books, covering 1817 thru March 1926, have been professionally scanned and are being digitally enhanced in preparation for being placed on line. Any of you who have ever tried to read some of the microfilm of early records, should understand the need to adjust the contrast and lighting to insure that all of the record can be easily read. It is hard to read some of those handwritten records so anything that makes them more legible will be a great help. An index is also being created. In addition to making these important records easily accessible by all, the originals can now be stored and preserved since it will not be necessary to handle them to get the information they contain. Deeds from 1983 to the present have been available on line for several years. All current documents are scanned and stored electronically in addition to the traditional ledgers. The former micro-filming operation was discontinued after all the older records were filmed.

Ms Gossett Hager and Kim Estep were given complimentary one year memberships in the society. We thank them both for their time and assistance.
